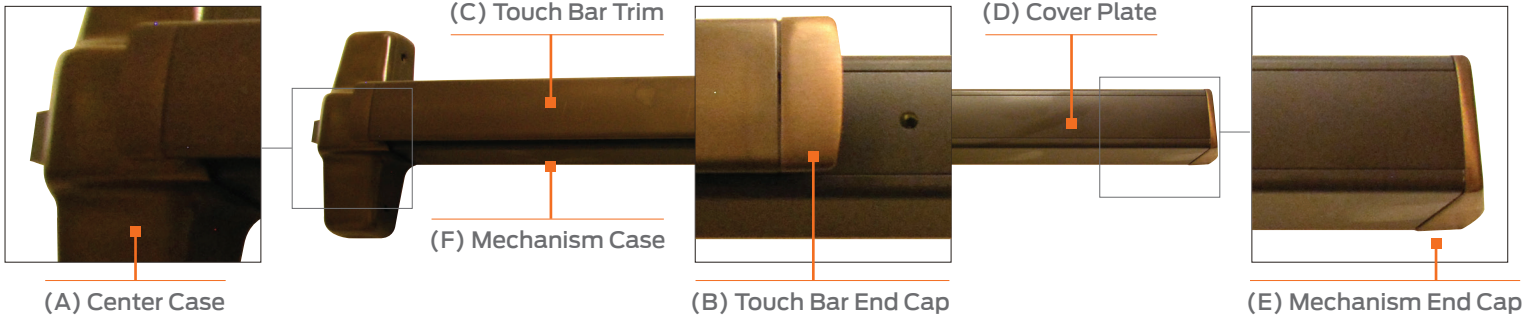
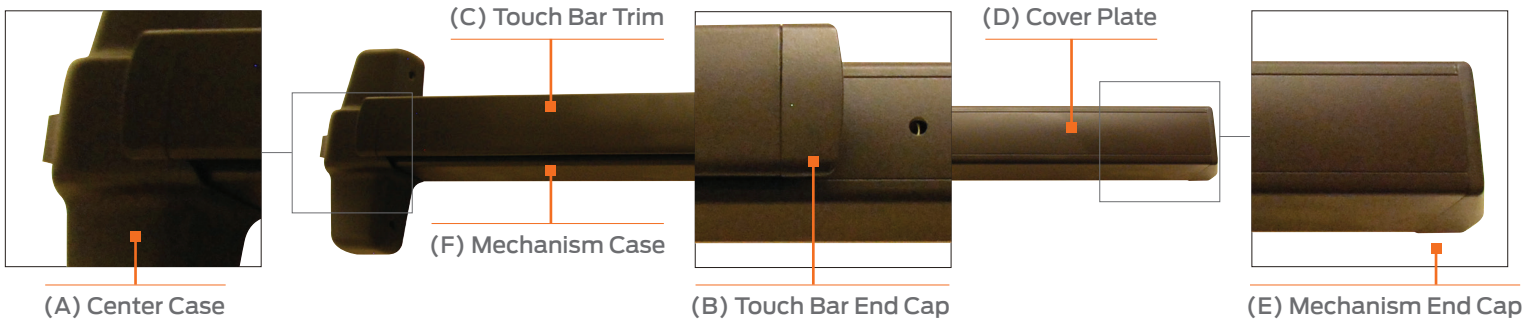

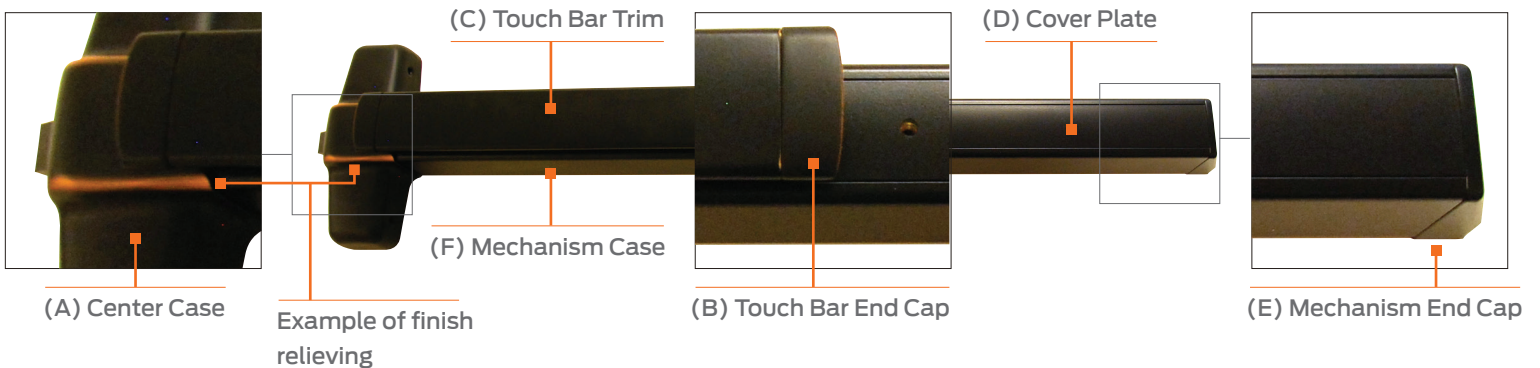

Additional finish information

Powder coat – provides a uniform finish over the entire surface that will resist wear and weathering.

Oil rubbed – Dark Oxidized Satin Bronze, Oil Rubbed finish that is BHMA listed. This is a living finish that will wear and weather over time.

Aged bronzed – offers a classic distinctive look that resists wear, weathering and patina. Relieved parts feature a soft bronze highlight.
